### Description:

Close to the ancient city of Machu Picchu, in the Vilcabamba-Amboro conservation corridor, the construction of an interoceanic road uniting Brazil with Peru jeopardises the tropical rainforest and one of the world's biodiversity hotspots.

This verified carbon standard dramatically reduces deforestation and the threat of moving communities and illegal logging by increasing surveillance in the area and establishing sustainable forest management practices.
